VACCINATIONS Please discuss with your veterinarian your furkids' recommended vaccines for their participation and Rally attendance.

DON'T FORGET TO BRING: Our weather in May can be unpredictable ranging from 50 to 70 therefore, keep an eye on the forecast and dress accordingly. Bring your own **lawn chair(s)**, **dog water bowl** (bottled water will be available for furkids and family members, an **X-PEN** so you and your dog(s) can enjoy the day, a **NON-RETRACTABLE leash**, credit cards (Visa, MC accepted) although we prefer cash or personal checks so that the organization doesn't incur additional fees.

Important PARKING Changes

Friday evening parking will be in the Park N Bark lot at Rally headquarters & signs will be posted.

SATURDAY parking will be available for faculty, volunteers and attendees at the Baileys Grove Campground. Frequent shuttle rides will be available to transport you, your Scots and travel gear. Shuttle Stop pick-ups will be clearly marked and staffed with volunteers to assist you. Please remember that we provide frequent shuttle service from the Baileys Grove Campground beginning at 7:45 am on Saturday.

HANDICAP PARKING CHANGES: Effective this year Saturday parking in the DCSR Bark N Park (meadow) Lot will be restricted to **only those attendees with state issued Handicapped placards or license plates** due to increased requests and limited available space.

Join national agility competitor, **Barbara Gibson** and Dude as they mentor you and your Scottie/wannabee in experiencing an agility course and tips for you to build upon in your yard and community! Barbara Gibson has enjoyed cohabitation with Scottish Terriers since 1998. In 2008, she began her journey in various dog sports with her Scotties, including agility, earthdog, obedience, Rally, barn hunt, and conformation. Her Scotties have been awarded or won several accolades, including the STCA Superior Performance Award; High in Trial in Obedience, Agility, and Rally; and Top Scottish Terrier at the AKC Agility Invitational (2015-17).

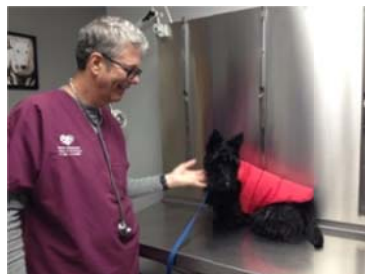
Mission POSSIBLE: Motivating Your Scottie For Obedience! Don't miss this **hands on** session with **Lucy Berninger** who will talk about training & motivating Scotties, a breed notorious for its willful independence. She will demonstrate with her Scottie, Ike, answer questions and provide hands on help with a few dogs if time allows. Lucy has trained and shown 8 Scotties for obedience competition since 1993, three of which have gone onto the Utility Dog title & one has been the only Scottie to have earned the Obedience Trial Championship title (OTCH). Her current Scottie, Ike, has earned a Utility Dog Excellent title (UDX) & has 44 points towards and OTCH title, including a High In Trial, with a score of 199. **Fee Session is \$15**

Arts & Crafts Class- Origami Scottie Mobile: Local Door County paper artist, **Nancy Akerly** is a retired public school educator and is a frequent faculty member at The Clearing, an adult folk school in Ellison Bay, WI. She is well known for her beautiful custom made boxes and origami. Nancy will instruct you in the nuances of making an origami scottie mobile that you can proudly display in your home or office. The **\$15/person fee** will include a variety of papers from which you select to make your own group of flying scots!
